

## Dumfries Cycling Club      Committee Meeting Minutes

### Committee members present:

1. Minutes of last meeting were approved. Proposed by BM. & seconded by R.McG.
2. Treasurers Report:
  - 123 members joined for 2018 with £5899. TLI race account to be finalised after series trophies are paid for; as with the open Loch Ken TT there will be a +ve balance on the event.
3. Club kit:
  - Next order to be placed 8<sup>th</sup> September with an approx. 6 week delivery.
4. Events calendar:
  - Loch Ken open TT was a successful event with over 70 entries despite a late course & HQ change because of an event in New Galloway. The club has been offered to host one of the RTTC classic series time trials next year on 12<sup>th</sup> May. CS has given a provisional positive response. CS
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Aug TLI race & series. As a new race & with 57 entries the event, venue & course were considered successful & would be simpler to organise in subsequent years. As with the open TT if sections the organisation can be delegated to responsible individuals it would make overall management much simpler & less stressful. It would also impart ownership of the organisation to a broader membership base. DN.  
CS proposed an out of season time keeping / marshalling training session to encourage helpers to come forward.  
Spreading the organisation of these open events across other D&G clubs was considered a good thing & to be built on next season.  
Presentation for the CTT & TLI series to be at Studio Velo when trophies are ready.

5. Saturday Rides:
  - Saturday rides generally working better with 4 group system.

- Ladies nights – Working ok with about 6 regulars out on a Monday.
- Monday speed night have been well supported this year.
- Monthly intro rides have not proven successful & to be dropped. Murry McP. has offered to accompany any novice rider who contacts the club.

6. Sportive Review: Final wash up meeting to be held early September. It was felt sportives in general & the Solway one in particular, were becoming less popular. DCC to pull out of co-organising the Solway Sportive in 2019 and focus resources on other open events.

7. New Web site: To be launched Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> with a new URL – thanks given to Garry on a lot of behind the scenes work. GC.
